**Course Description:** Students will learn how to become more effective communicators through writing. The following represents the areas of study:

-  Writing Modes/Genre: Expository, Narrative
-  Text Structures/Author's Purpose
-  The Writing Process
-  6 Writing Traits
-  Sentence Structure
-  Grammar: Parts of Speech
-  Spelling, Capitalization, and Punctuation
-  Revising and Editing/Proofreading Skills
-  Journal Writing
-  Newspapers in Education activities (Teen Speak)

**Grading Policy:** Each six weeks grade will reflect the academic progress of the student and will be determined as follows:

-  50% daily work - minimum of 6
-  50% tests - minimum of 4

(BISD Grading Procedures pgs. 27-28)

**Homework Policy:** Students will be assigned homework on a regular basis. Usually, homework will consist of work not completed in class, including written compositions. It is important that students turn homework in on time. In addition, studying for a test is considered a homework assignment. All students will have a homework folder. (BISD Grading Procedures pg. 15)

**Late/Missing Work Policy:** Students are to turn in all work by specified due dates. Late and missing assignments will be accepted with 30-50 points deducted which can result in a failing grade.

**Tardies:** All students are expected to be seated by the time the tardy bell rings. Tardy #1 through Tardy #4 - Parents will be contacted and tardy documented. Tardy #5 – Office Referral.

**Test Policy:** A minimum of four tests will be administered per six weeks. Tests will include areas of study mentioned in course description. Students will be informed several days in advance so that they can begin reviewing and studying. Written compositions may also be counted as test grades.
